

Thank you for joining us for a dementia-friendly film at The Henry Ford. To help prepare you for your visit, we have put together the following pre-visit guide.

When you arrive at The Henry Ford, you can park in the large parking lot off of Oakwood Boulevard. The Giant Screen Experience, where you will watch the movie, is inside Henry Ford Museum of American Innovation. You can enter through the doors to the Welcome Center of the museum.

If you would like to purchase popcorn and/or a drink, you can do so at the concession stand.



When you enter the lobby, you will see a table with a black tablecloth that says, "The Henry Ford Accessibility." If you have already purchased your movie tickets, you can check in here. Everyone will need a ticket, including your companion(s). If you need to purchase movie tickets, you can head to the ticket counter straight ahead or to the concession stand, which is around the corner to your left.



You will then go into the Giant Screen Experience. Someone will take your ticket on your way inside. If you need an Assistive Listening Device (ALD), please let a staff member know.







When you see this sign, you know you are heading in the right direction for the movie.



You can sit wherever you would like. Seating is available in the first few rows of the Giant Screen Experience for those who prefer not to climb a lot of stairs. If you would prefer to sit higher up, you will need to climb more stairs. Please be sure that your companion assists you if you need help with the stairs.

If you are using a wheelchair and would like to sit in a higher row, there is an elevator in the lobby of the Welcome Center. It will take you directly to the second floor of the Giant Screen Experience, where you will find seating for wheelchair users and their companions.

If you need to use the restroom, there are restrooms in the lobby of the Welcome Center. There are also companion care restrooms with adult changing tables farther down the hall from the Welcome Center.







During the movie, the lights in the theater will be on and the sound will be down. You can get up and move around whenever you would like. You can also talk, sing, laugh, and/or dance at any time during the movie. If you need to leave the movie for a quiet break, you can do that too.

The second floor of the Giant Screen Experience has restrooms as well. Feel free to use the restrooms at any time, even during the movie. Your companion can accompany you. Your seat will still be there when you return.
